The Open is now full and we have waiting lists for a number of events in Session 3. Therefore, changes to accepted events will not be possible.

We ask that you take careful note of the following important Event Information, in particular, the COVID regulations and brief your swimmers and parents accordingly.

We continue to monitor the current COVID-19 situation and it may be necessary to revise the below conditions and apply further restrictions to comply with Government guidance and/or the venue's COVID policy in the case of changes to the current situation.

Withdrawals

- If a swimmer is unable to swim or wishes to withdraw it is important that such withdrawals are emailed to bramcoteopen@gmail.com ideally prior to 20th November. If there any last-minute withdrawals on the day these need to be notified before the warm up of each session.

Event programmes

- No printed programmes will be available but start sheets will be provided to those with a coaches pass.
- The event programme will be online prior to the event and available to be downloaded or printed as required. A link will be sent nearer the time.

COVID -19 Regulations

- ***An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease. Therefore, if you choose to participate in an organised event, you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19. By attending or participating in this competition you voluntarily assume all risks associated with exposure to COVID-19.***
- ***You should follow the latest government advice with respect to COVID-19***
- ***If you have displayed symptoms or have tested positive for COVID-19 you should follow government advice. Do not attend the Open meet; instead, you should report your positive test to the government track and trace system and isolate as advised.***
- ***Spectators are currently allowed but should be limited to one per swimmer wherever possible to reduce crowding.***

- ***Due to the heightened risk present with large numbers of people, face masks are strongly recommended to be worn by all spectators during the event, and also by swimmers when not on poolside. Whilst we acknowledge this is a personal choice, your health and safety at the event is our highest priority.***
- ***Face masks for officials and poolside helpers is optional as we recognise that it gets very hot and stuffy on poolside.***
- ***Ventilation of the pool area will be increased during and between sessions by opening external doors for periods of time to increase air circulation as appropriate.***
- ***If we need to put further COVID restrictions in place, then we will inform everyone by addition of a COVID Announcement document on the [Bramcote Open webpage](#). If government guidance changes at the last minute it may be necessary to enforce further restrictions on the day without prior notice.***

Changing rooms

- The changing rooms at Bramcote Leisure Centre have a very strict no shoe policy - shoes must be removed prior to entering the changing room area and either placed in shoe rack area or in kit bags.
- Please instruct swimmers to use the changing facility in a careful and non-disruptive manner as there will be leisure centre activities taking place in the training pool. Changing facilities are shared with the general public.

General behaviour

- Please keep swimmers under supervision while poolside during the event and keep the seating area as tidy as possible.
- Please remove all litter from the club seating area at the end of the day - black bin liners will be provided to each club to collect their rubbish. We will collect these in at the end of the meet and ensure they are disposed of accordingly.
- There are no catering facilities within the leisure centre. Therefore, please bring the food and drink required for all sessions attending.

Retail outlets present

- Sporty Swim will be in attendance with a range of swimwear and accessories on sale.
- Butlers Medal engravers will be present and are available to engrave any medals for a fee. Butlers Medals accept both cash and card payments.
